with a wine and appetizer reception and more.

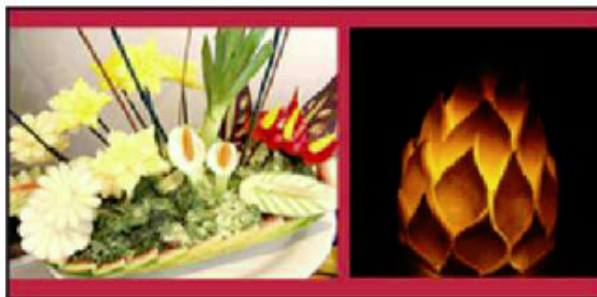
Saturday, April 20th, 5-8pm.

award-winning chef Ray Duey carves fruit and veggie sculptures onsite!



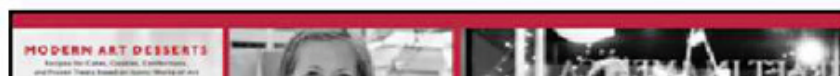
Ray Duey garnish art: fruit and vegetable floral arrangement, melon lantern
