Online Audition Requests

All applicants must submit an audition request online. Please plan ahead and sign up online on or before Monday January 8th. Auditions times will be assigned and communicated via email and director correspondence (*times will be assigned between 4:00 and 8:00 PM on the date of the audition*). Have your signed application and be ready to audition up to 15 minutes before your assigned time. The online audition request is **the only way** to secure an audition slot, therefore we encourage you to submit your online audition request sooner rather than later.

Note for Walk-Ins

"Walk-In" auditions will be assigned **only** in the event that there are time slots available with a given adjudicator. "Walk-Ins" will be placed in the earliest open time slot, pending availability. Please see the "Walk-In Audition Policy" for more information.

Audition Requirements

Scales: Applicants are to prepare the scales provided on the website listed above for their instrument. Students should perform these scales using the indicated tempos and bowings/articulations.

Prepared Piece: Applicants are to prepare the selected piece provided on the website above for their instrument. Correct notes and rhythms, as well as dynamics/phrasing, articulations/bowings, musicality, and tone/intonation are among the aspects on which your performance will be judged.

Sight-reading: During the audition, applicants will be given a short piece to sight-read. After approximately one minute of quiet study, the applicant will be asked to perform the selection to the best of their ability. Credit will be given for continuous playing and consistency of pulse, rhythm, and style.

ORCHESTRA WINDS & PERCUSSION: *Our highest scoring wind and percussion players will also perform as musicians in our Symphony Orchestra.*
