




President's Report to the Governing Board January 17, 2017

2016 Fall Finals De-Stress Station



Finals week at Cuyamaca College can be an extremely stressful time, so to address that strain, allow students to take a break from studying and unwind, Student Affairs' Cross Cultural Ambassadors and Health Services hosted a "De-

stress Station" on December 14 at Central Park. To help reduce the stress of completing papers, projects, and final exams, free coffee and tea along with fruit, muffins, and bagels were made available to students along with fun and relaxing activities including music, arts and crafts tables, and friendly people to chat with. The San Diego Humane Society therapy dogs were also present to mingle with the



students to relieve stress with their calming effect. This semi-annual event demonstrates the continued commitment of the college to ease the anxiety of finals in fun and creative ways.

Honor Students

At Cuyamaca College, approximately 703 students made the "honor roll" for the fall 2016 semester. 248 students received the Vice President's honor letter, having obtained a 3.5 to 3.9 grade point average for 12 or more units in which a letter grade was received, and 131 students received the President's congratulatory letter, having earned a 4.0 GPA for the fall. In addition, 324 students received an honor letter signed by either the College President or the Vice President of Student Services from both colleges congratulating each of them for their scholastic achievement while attending classes at both colleges during the fall semester.
