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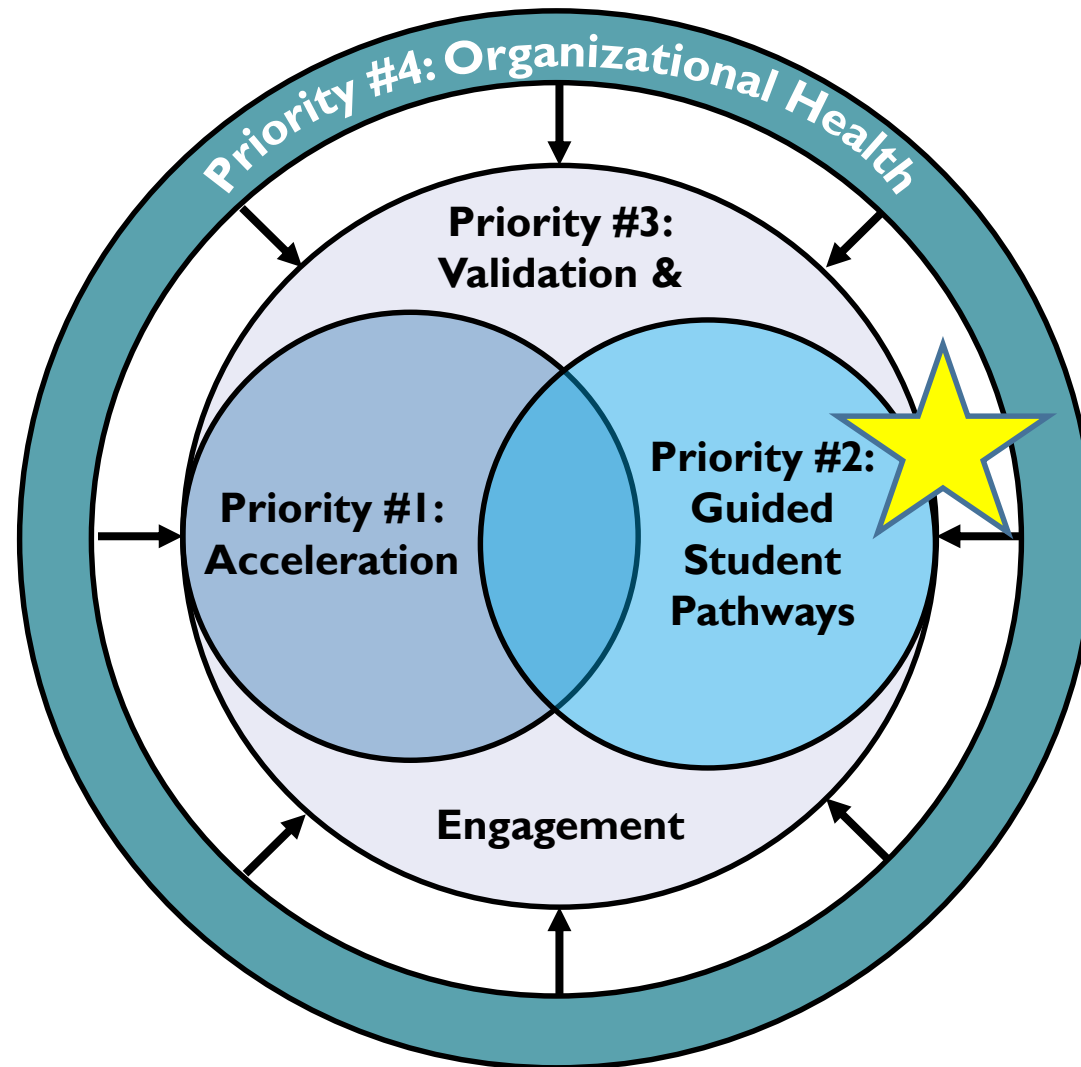

What are Guided Student Pathways?

- Structured academic and career paths for students
- Institution-wide effort to remove barriers and create bridges to student completion
- Integrated support services, programs, and instruction to focus on the holistic **student experience**
- Student, completion, and equity focused
- Informed by research and Completion By Design model

The California Guided Pathways Project

- Pilot project with several partners (e.g., AACCC) to assist 15 to 20 California Community Colleges implement guided student pathways
- Colleges must apply for technical assistance/coaching through competitive process
- Application due February 28, 2017

California Guided Pathways Model

Focused on 4 Themes

1. Clarify pathways to student end goals
2. Help students choose and enter a pathway
3. Help students stay on the path
4. Ensure that students are learning

What's in it for us?

- Hands-on technical assistance and coaching for our strategic priority and “big bet” (guided pathways)
- Scaling up and simplifying what we are already trying to do
- Possibility for funding from the state (\$150 million for colleges to implement guided pathways)
