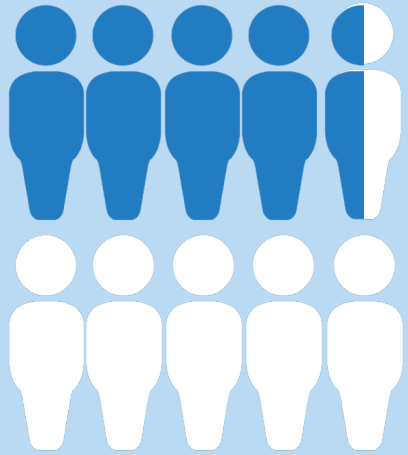


Connection

In 2017-18, **46%** of applicants enrolled at Cuyamaca¹



Compared to our service area, Cuyamaca has a **larger** percentage of white students and a **smaller** percentage of Latinx students²

Entry

In their first year in college...

26% completed transfer-level English¹

23% completed transfer-level math¹

25% completed 15+ degree-applicable units³

Progress

61% persisted from Fall to Spring¹



This rate was even **lower** for our Black/African-American students (49%) and our Latinx students (58%)¹

Completion

Our **531** degree-earners accumulated an average of **91 units**¹



Transition

455 students transferred to a four-year institution⁴

Approximately **1 in 3** exiting students who did not transfer attained the San Diego County regional living wage of \$33,761⁵
