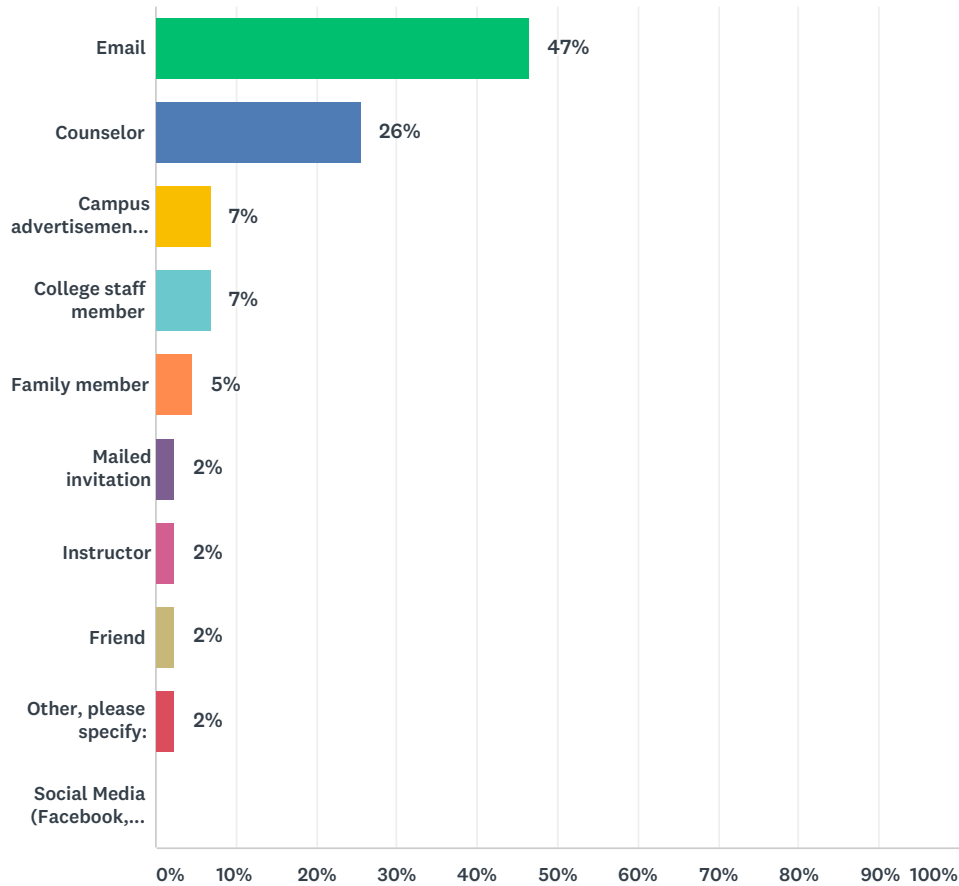


Q1 How did you first learn about the commencement ceremony?

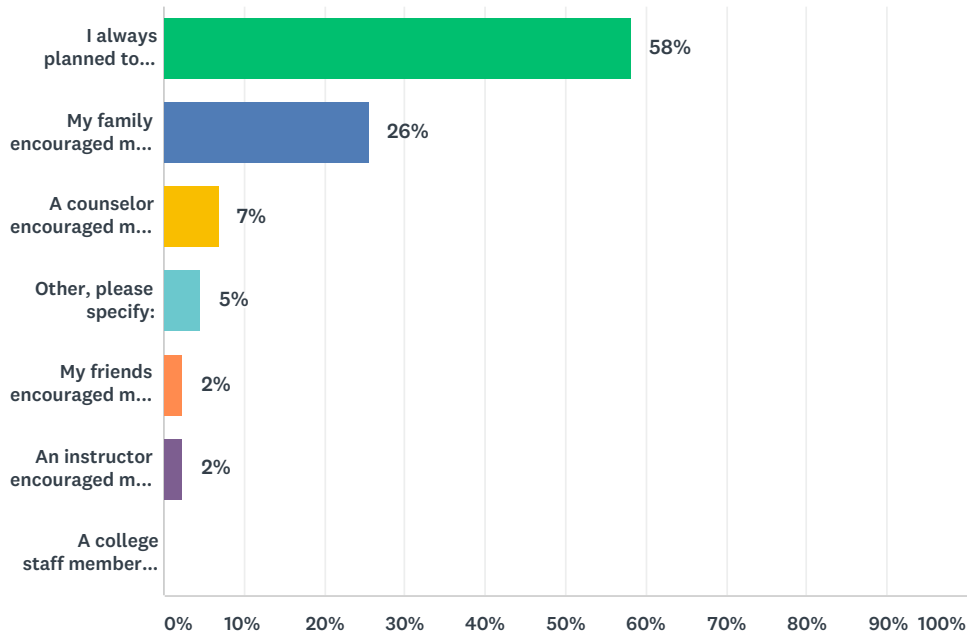

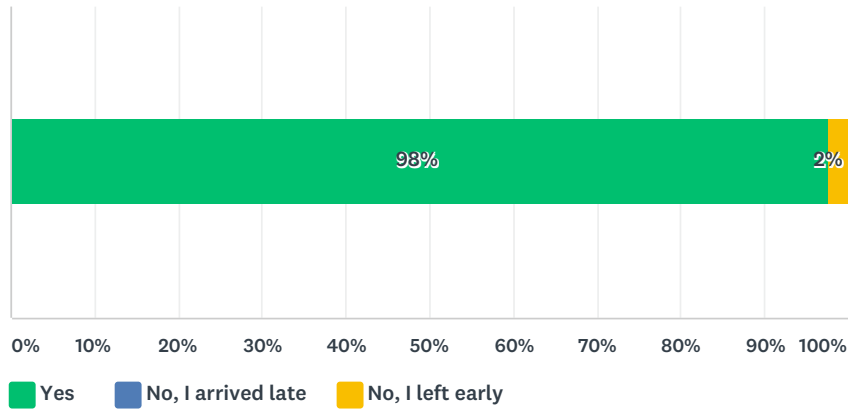

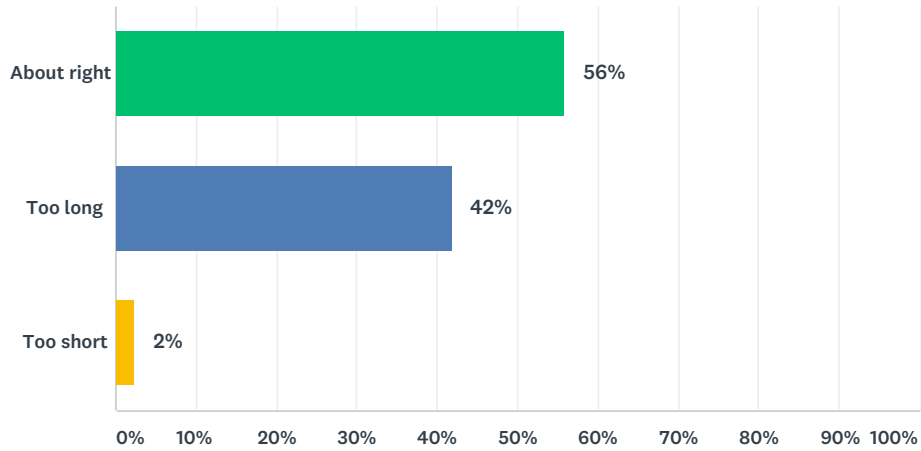

Q5 Did you feel the length of the ceremony was too long, too short, or about right?

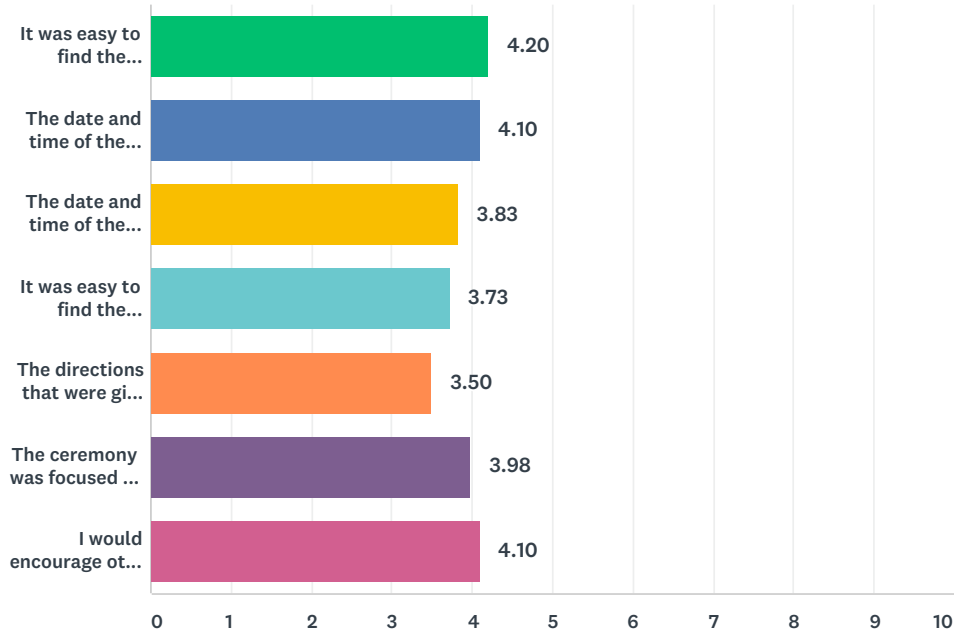

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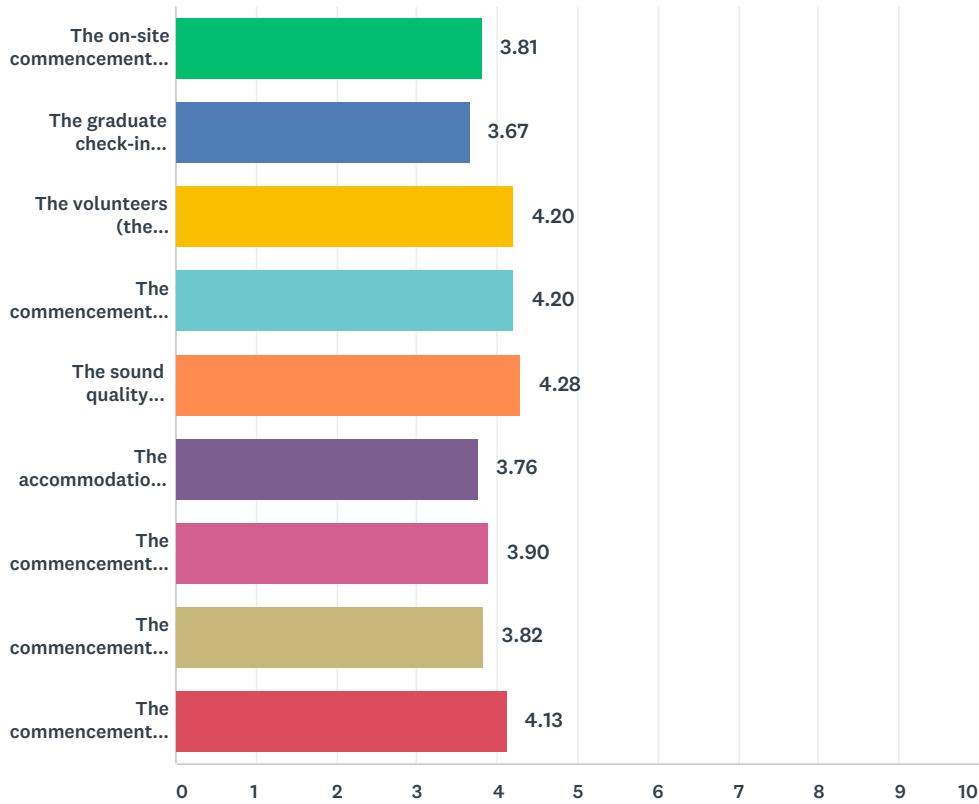
