





Q1 Prior to taking this survey, how would you describe your familiarity of Cuyamaca College's Associated Student Government (ASG)?








Q5 What types of events would you be most likely to attend on campus? Please select all that apply.


Q6 How do you typically receive information about campus events? Please select all that apply.






