


Cuyamaca and Grossmont College Application Instructions

Step 1

CREATE AN OPENCCC ACCOUNT

Visit the gcccd.edu website

- On the home page click the yellow "Get Started" button located in the center banner. 

- On the following page, view step one. Select & click the school you'd like to attend.

Step 2

COMPLETE THE OPENCCC APPLICATION

Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the OpenCCC Application

- Students without a Social Security Number may still complete the application. Simply check the "do not have" box near the bottom of the page.

Check this box if you do not have a Social Security Number. International students, nonresident aliens, and other [exceptions](#), may not.



Step 3

COMPLETE A CUYAMACA OR GROSSMONT COLLEGE APPLICATION

Complete the Enrollment Tab & Account Tab

- For Term Applying for, select either Fall 2020 or Summer 2020.
 - If you want to remain eligible to take classes in summer, choose Summer 2020.
- Your Educational Goal and Major are not permanent, they may be changed later.

Step 4

REPORT YOUR EDUCATIONAL HISTORY

Complete the Education Tab

- Your college enrollment Status will be "First-time student in college (after leaving high school)."
- Your High School Education level will be "Received high school diploma from U.S. school."
- You will then be prompted to enter your High School Completion date. Unless you know your graduation date, please select **June 4th or June 5th, 2020**.

Step 5

INDICATE YOUR CITIZENSHIP STATUS

Complete the Citizenship Tab

- U.S. citizens will need their Social Security Number.
- Non-citizens will need their Alien Registration Number or Visa type with issue and expiration dates in order to complete the application.
- Some students may not have any of the listed documents & that's OK, you can still apply - select "Other" from the drop down box and then check the "No Documents" box when completing the application. Your information will remain confidential.
 - If you select No Documents you may be eligible for AB-540 - Visit <http://bit.ly/ccAB540>
- If you are a former or current military dependent, indicate so.



Step 6

REPORT YOUR RESIDENCY

Complete the Residency Tab

- If you are not a resident, but have completed three or more years at a California High School, you may still be eligible for in-state tuition.



Step 7

TELL US ABOUT INTERESTS

Complete the Needs & Interests Tab

- Indicate any programs and services that are of interest to you.
- Selecting one of the boxes allows these programs to contact you with more information about their services.

Step 8

TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF

Complete the Demographics Tab

- Please be as accurate as possible.
- If you don't feel comfortable reporting, please select "Decline To State."
