Bible, Theological, and Philosophical Formation: The number of BTP Formation General Education Requirements varies based on number of units transferred. Please refer to the catalog, in which you begin the Psychology program to determine how many BTP units are required (Bible courses are completed at APU).

BA in Psychology transfer reminders:

- APU accepts fully completed **IGETC** and **CSU GE Certifications** (partial certifications will not be honored).
- The university can give credit for no more than 70 units from a two-year college or a maximum of 90 units from a four-year institution. 30 transferable units are required for admission into the Professional Undergraduate BA in Psychology program.
- No course from a two-year or community college can transfer to meet an APU upper division requirement.
- Any course may still be transferable for non-general studies elective units *if* designated as CSU/UC transferable in the course catalog.
- A minimum C (2.0) grade-point average is required for all transferable college work completed for admission to APU.
- A total of 43 units are required for the major. A minimum 2.0 grade-point average is required in all major courses, including the specified General Education classes or prerequisites. Students must pass all required courses with a C or higher.
