CalFresh is the name in California of the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP) and it's the nation's anti-hunger Federal program.

Eligibility requirements:

If you are taking 6 units or more this semester, are you:

- Between the ages of 18 and 49?
- Physically and mentally fit to work?

If yes, then you must meet at least one of the following to be eligible:

- Working 20 hours a week or 80 a month *or*
- Approved for Federal or State Work-Study *or CalGrant A/B*
- Have a child under 12 *or*
- Receiving CalWORKS *or*
- Enrolled in **EOP** or programs that increase employability and programs for current former foster youth.
