- **We now accept Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT).** A California Community College student who has earned an ADT in Business Administration, Child Development, Criminal Justice Systems, Political Science, or Psychology will be granted priority admission to Alliant into a similar bachelor degree program with a guarantee of junior standing if the student meets all Alliant admission requirements.
- **We have lowered our tuition significantly.** We understand financing a college education can be difficult, and we have decreased our per unit cost to accommodate more students seeking an education focused on professional practice.
- **We have new scholarships.** Alliant has dedicated scholarship funds for students who qualify, in support of our mission and commitment to assist our diverse student body, as well as a variety of students access to a college education. Additionally, Alliant maintains its commitment to our active military personnel and veterans by offering the Yellow Ribbon Program to those that qualify.
- **We have added Fast-Track Master's Degrees.** The quickest route to a master's degree, the Fast-Track option, lets students spend the last semester of their undergraduate year taking bridge classes. These graduate-level courses count toward both the completion of their bachelor's degree and a master's degree.

Major preparation / general education requirements: Alliant International University will transfer up to 60 lower division transferable units and all articulated coursework listed below in preparation for its undergraduate majors. Alliant International University will also accept CSU GE-Breadth Certification to satisfy Alliant's lower division general education requirements.

Admission requirements:

1. A completed application.
2. Official transcripts:
 - High School Students and/or students who have earned less than 24 college units: An official High School Transcript as well as official transcripts from all colleges attended that should be considered for the transfer credit evaluation
 - Students who have earned 24 or more college units: An official high school graduation date as well as official transcripts from all colleges attended that should be considered for the transfer credit evaluation
3. A nonrefundable application fee of \$65.
4. The minimum grade point average (GPA) requirement for undergraduate admission is a cumulative of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
