**SDSU WPA PREPARATION** | The WPA is an exam that must be taken before the end of the first semester at SDSU. Transfer students are now eligible to take the WPA once they have received an offer of admission. Students who do not take the examination by the end of their first semester at SDSU will not be able to register for future terms. Please be aware that the university offers workshops that help break down the exam and prepare you for best results. Visit <http://wpa.sdsu.edu> for more information.

**ADMISSION RESULTS** | We know how stressful it can be to receive your admission results. Here are the dates to look out for. If you have further questions please feel free to contact or visit us in person.

**CSU** | March

**UC** | Mid March thru April

**PRIVATE** | May thru July

**If denied admission, please contact the Transfer Center as soon as possible so we can assist you in what steps to take further!**

**ADT VERIFICATION** | Students must apply for graduation, to ensure sufficient processing time for CSU E-Verification. It is highly recommended to apply for the ADT Degree by February 13th, 2020. Final application deadline is March 6, 2020, so that electronic ADT verification can be done by March 6th deadline.

**DEADLINE TO ACCEPT OFFER OF ADMISSION** | All students who are offered admission must accept the offer by the deadline.

**CSU** | May 1st Intent to Enroll

**UC** | June 1st Statement of Intent to Register

**PRIVATE** | 3 Weeks after offer has been given \*check university\*
