Applicants for admission to the Los Angeles College of Chiropractic must have completed a Minimum of 90 semester or 135 quarter units of college work leading to a baccalaureate degree in the arts or sciences with a cumulative G.P.A. of at least 2.50 (2.75 preferential), on a 4.0 scale. These requirements may increase annually culminating to a bachelor degree and G.P.A. of 3.0. **Please note: starting Fall of 2003, 30 semester units of upper division work will be required.** Science courses must be taken in sequential order and must include participatory laboratories. All of the following courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
